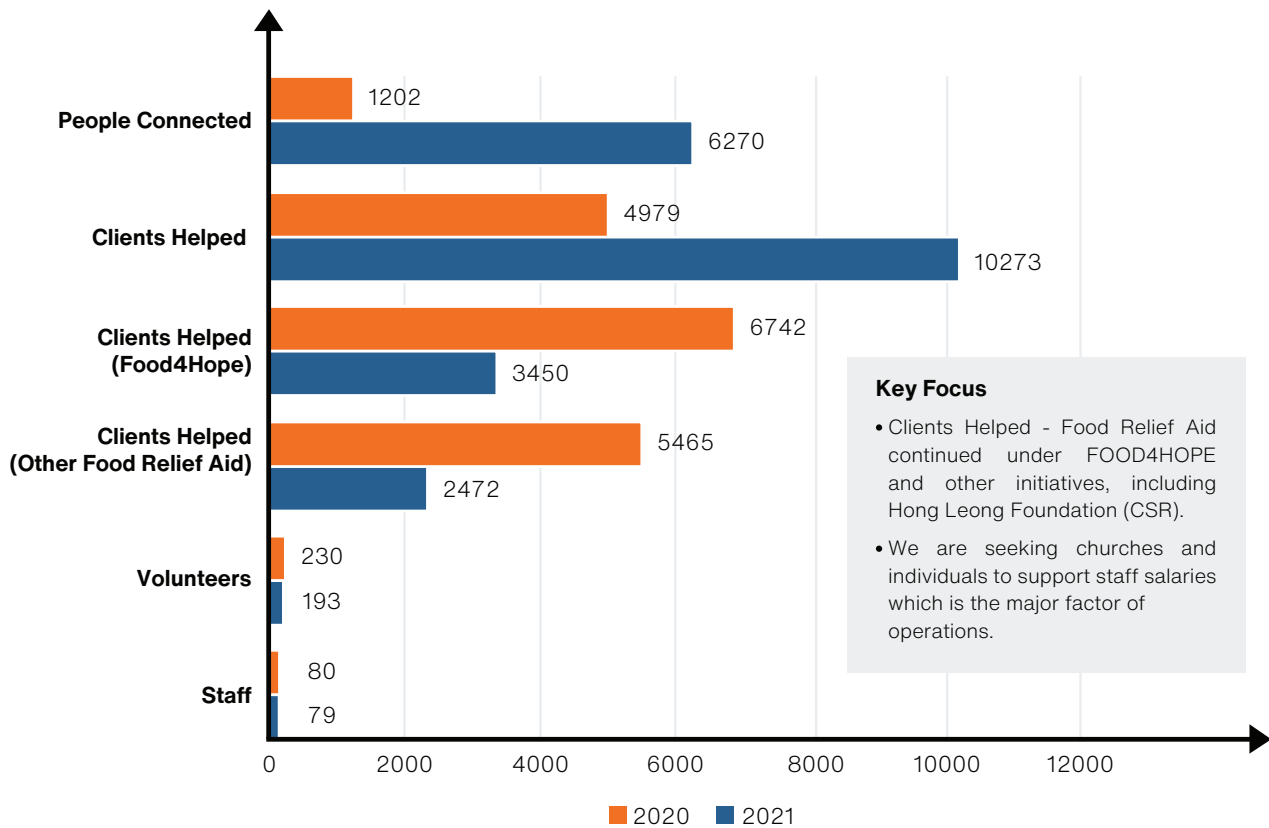


Finance Report 2021



Greetings to all our faithful donors and supporters. We have been going through a very challenging year with the economy struggling during the Movement Control Orders or lockdowns. As very trying a time as it was for all of us, God has not forgotten the poor and needy communities. We are encouraged that our donors and supporters continue to give their best to help us in times of financial needs. As of November 2021, we were facing a deficit of almost half a million ringgits and we continued to pray and trust God to overcome this deficit. We did not write an appeal letter for this deficit and God has moved our donors' hearts to give beyond the deficit. We are expecting a small surplus prior to our external audit. We are encouraged by your generous and faithful giving throughout the year 2021. We continue to thank the Lord for His miraculous provision.

Ministry Brief and Moving Ahead ...

We thank God for your continuous support that enabled us to establish new centres in Klang and Raub. We have just started the operations and are looking out for church partners to network with us. For instance, the support and food aid programme for the poor communities and HIV patients at Hospital Tengku Ampuan Rahimah's (HTAR) in Klang.

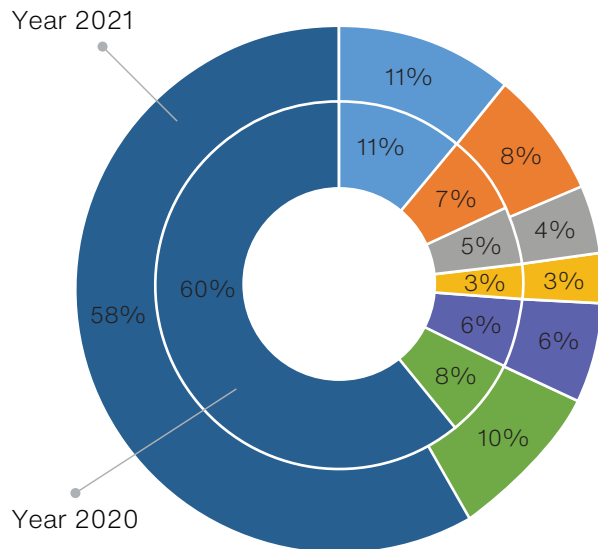
Our partnership in relief work such as FOOD4HOPE targeted those communities that include the hard core urban poor, orang asli/asal communities and refugees. We seek your continuous financial and prayer support to meet the overwhelming needs in our nation. Please remember to uphold all our caregivers who are frontliners in reaching out to the vulnerable groups.

As such, the key highlights for 2021 included our budget that had gone up from RM5.3 million to RM5.4 million to run the entire year-long operations. We currently have about 80 full-time staff serving in Sabah, Sarawak, Perak, Pahang and the Klang valley. Please see below charts.

Please pray together with us as we seek God and ask of Him to meet our financial needs. As the prophet Isaiah proclaimed the Lord says, "See I am doing a new thing!" (Isaiah 43:19). We are excited to see what is in store in the coming year and it is our desire is to see God doing a new thing in transforming our nation.

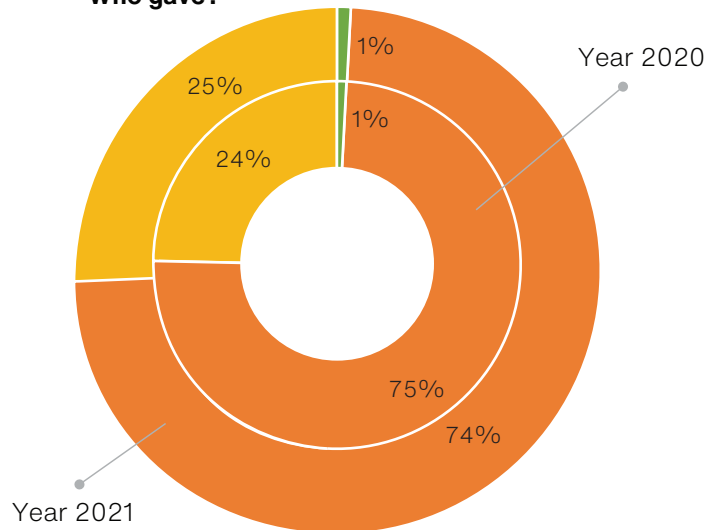
